

#1 SENATE BEGINS ITS “BYRD BATH”

The Senate will begin Byrd Bath arguments on what can remain in the draft text beginning on Sunday. #3 GENIUS ACT PASSES SENATE

The Senate passed the GENIUS Act on Tuesday on a 68-30 vote. This bill would regulate stablecoins – a big win for the crypto industry. Despite a strong bipartisan vote in the Senate, it’s unclear how the House will proceed with this bill.
