#1 BLANCHE NOMINATION IN QUESTION

#2 FAUCI TESTIFIES IN COMMITTEE

Dr. Anthony Fauci was forced to testify in front of the Senate Homeland Security and Government Affairs Committee about (in part) new revelations that emerged in his diaries after Chairman Paul released them publicly. Dr. Fauci asserted the 5th Amendment for every question asked. One of his lawyers was also removed from the Committee during the proceedings. The Chairman has said he will advance contempt proceedings given Dr. Fauci's assertion of the 5th Amendment after he has already been given a pardon by President Biden.
