## #1 DHS HEADED FOR SHUTDOWN

## #2 HOUSE FARM BILL RELEASED

Republicans on the House Committee on Agriculture have released their text of the Farm Bill. Democrats on the Committee have expressed their opposition to the bill. The Senate has not yet announced when its version will be released, but the House bill will be considered in committee on February 23rd.

## #3 HOUSE PASSES HOUSING BILL

The House of Representatives passed the Housing for the 21st Century Act by a vote of 390 to 9. The legislation was developed by Republicans and Democrats on the House Committee on Financial Services, which focused on creating solutions to increase supply.
