

Increased Funding for LWCF

The One Big Beautiful Bill included a <u>provision</u> that increased the revenue-sharing cap for the Outer Continental Shelf every year, which is used to fund the Land and Water Conservation Fund (LWCF). The Department of Interior announced implementation of the increased cap from FY25 through FY34. The cap

was previously at 12.5% or a total of \$125M for the LWCF Stateside program. It's been increased to 25% or up to \$162.5 million. There is also more funding for Gulf-producing states for coastal protection and restoration.

Appropriations Debate Begins in the House

The Fix Our Forests Act, a comprehensive bill to combat wildfire, is expected to be marked up in the Senate Agriculture Committee this fall. The bill was introduced by Sens. Sheehy (R-MT), Padilla (D-CA), Curtis (R-UT), and Hickenlooper (D-CO) as an amended version of the bill that passed out of the House earlier this year. The bill makes changes to how the Forest Service manages forests on federal lands, streamlines environmental analyses, and establishes a wildfire intelligence center. Senate Agriculture, Forestry, and Nutrition Committee members are working on amendments ahead of the markup.

Great American Outdoors Act Hearing

The House Natural Resources Committee will hold a field hearing on "The Great American Outdoors Act: Modernizing and Maintaining National Parks to Celebrate America's 250th Birthday." The hearing will be held at Jenny Lake Visitor Center in Grand Teton National Park, Wyoming, and livestreamed here.
