Shutdown RIFs Skip Key Outdoor Recreation Agencies

Despite thousands of layoffs across a range of federal agencies during the ongoing shutdown, the Department of the Interior and the Department of Agriculture have not been on lists summarizing reductions in force (RIFs) since the shutdown began. A federal judge stalled this round of layoffs, citing process issues related to requirements in moving forward with agency RIFs. It is unclear what steps the Administration will take as the shutdown continues (now on its 16th day).
