## #1 HOUSE FINISHES APPROPRIATIONS WORK

The House Committee on Appropriations has officially passed all 12 appropriations bills after having passed the final three spending bills, which are now awaiting action by the Senate. This is a significant accomplishment given the many hurdles appropriators have had to overcome to get both sides of the political aisle in alignment.

## #2 PRESIDENT TRUMP REVERSES COURSE ON TARIFFS

## #3 PBM LANGUAGE FINALLY MOVES IN HOUSE

The House has included reforms to pharmacy benefit managers in the recent funding package. These reforms have been a looming priority issue for years. Rep. Carter (R-GA) has been leading the effort, and it will likely spur additional reforms in the future. The Senate now has to weigh whether to pass those reforms as well.
