## #1 ATTORNEY GENERAL EXITS DOJ

## #2 PRESIDENT ADDRESSES WAR IN IRAN

President Trump gave a prime-time speech to provide updates on the ongoing conflict in Iran. He highlighted how the U.S. military has dismantled Iran's armed forces. He also addressed the Strait of Hormuz, noting, “When this conflict is over, the strait will open up naturally. It will just open up naturally. They're going to want to be able to sell oil because that's all they have to try and rebuild.”

## #3 PRESIDENT SENDS BUDGET TO CONGRESS

President Trump sent his proposed Fiscal Year 2027 budget to Congress this week. The budget includes \$2.2 trillion in total spending, including \$1.5 trillion for defense spending (representing a 44% increase) and / \$73 billion reduction in non-defense spending.
