House FY27 Markups Underway, Senate Continues Oversight Hearings

Last week, the House Appropriations Committee marked up its FY27 Financial Services and Military Construction-Veterans Affairs bills at the subcommittee level. Full committee markups will be held tomorrow morning and continue into Wednesday if necessary. Here's the full markup schedule in the House:
