#1 PRESIDENT AGREES TO CEASEFIRE

President Trump agreed to a two-week ceasefire as tensions and rhetoric were increasing between leaders in Iran and the United States. Part of the agreement included a demand to reopen the Strait of Hormuz, which has happened.

#2 CLAY FULLER WINS MTG SEAT

Clay Fuller (R-GA) won the election to represent the 14th congressional district in Georgia, which Marjorie Taylor Greene recently vacated. While Republicans celebrated Fuller's election, Democrats were quick to point out that the margin of victory was significantly narrower than the previous election for that district, highlighting potential softer support among Republicans.
